Language requirements for incoming exchange students	Students may submit test scores (TOEFL IBT 71 or IELTS 6.0 minimum), but test scores are not required of exchange and study abroad students to SUU. If students do not submit a test score, they must submit a form completed by a person at their home university who is qualified to evaluate English proficiency. In particular, students must be able to navigate daily life in the U.S., read and comprehend academic texts, understand their rights and responsibilities, and know how to get help, if necessary.

Housing available to incoming exchange students	On-campus and off-campus housing are available to all students. Host family housing is also available but limited. Living costs (estimated)	Housing: \$450 per month Meals: \$350 per month Personal Expenses: \$250 per month (TOTAL estimated living costs per semester: \$4000)
Visa requirements	Students coming to SUU on exchange will need to obtain a J visa. If they are fee-paying students, they may come on a J or an F visa, depending on which they prefer. They will apply for their visa after receiving their official acceptance and visa support documents from SUU.
