## **TUITION & SCHOLARSHIPS**

Mississippi College is ranked as one of the BEST VALUE universities in the US because of its low tuition, affordable cost of living, and high-quality instruction. The tuition and fees for two academic semesters for undergraduate and graduate are as follows:

All first-year undergraduate students receive a \$2,000 scholarship for the first 2 semesters with GPA of 2.5 or above.

SAT or ACT is NOT REQUIRED for undergraduate admission. But students with good ACT/SAT scores may be eligible for academic scholarships. After the first year, undergraduates can apply for merit-based scholarships.

All first-year graduate students receive a \$1,500 scholarship per semester with GPA of 3.0 or above; \$2,000 is awarded to straight-A
